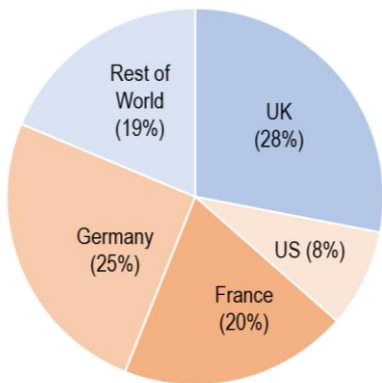


Facts Executive Education Service Pack Faculty/Trainer

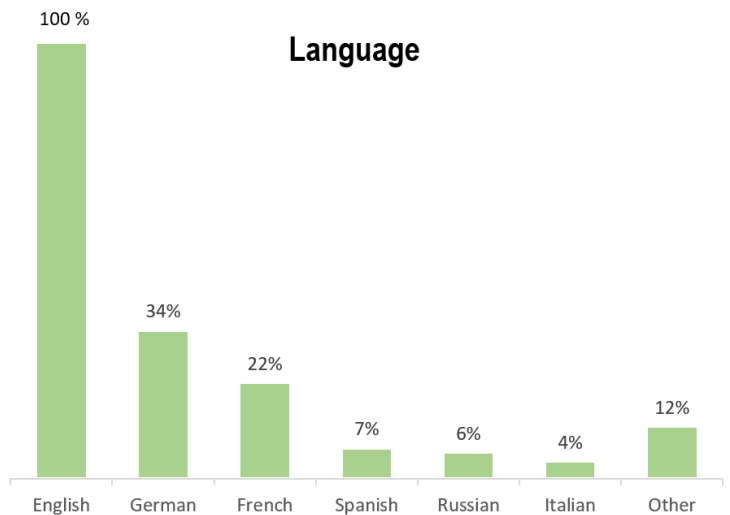

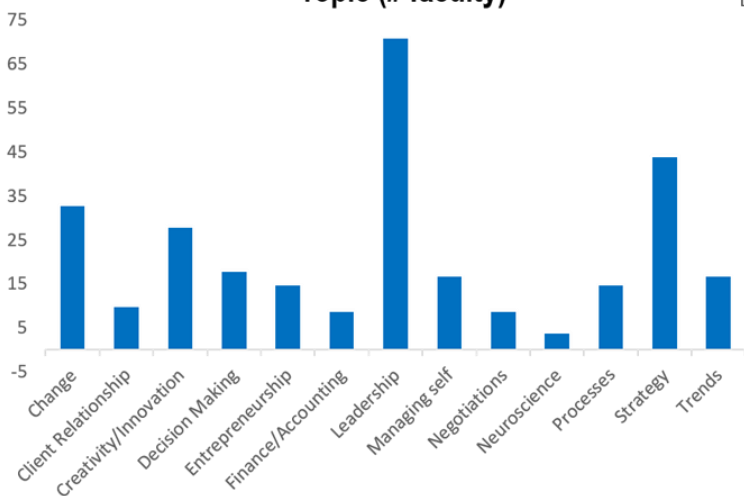
The database contains faculty/lecturers who teach executives interactively worldwide. Sometimes, however, it is important to have a local perspective, be it for regular workshops in the preparation/follow-up or to have an understanding of local markets. Approximately 70% of the faculty lives in Europe, the rest throughout the world.

In addition to English as the main language for many Executive Education programs, it is often important to provide faculty/lecturers in the local language. This is especially true for soft skills such as leadership, coaching and negotiation, but also for local differences in the markets. The database therefore contains almost 70 lecturers who speak other languages besides English.

The topics in Executive Education are diverse. There are 13 key subjects ranging from change to trends. Behind it hide however altogether nearly 150 sub-topics such as Digitization, Execution, Resilience, Six Sigma, VUCA, which can be searched for separately.

All the top business schools in the world are present. Some such as Duke CE and ESMT Berlin are more strongly represented, due to their business model or their smaller size, which results in an increased use of External/Adjunct or Affiliate Faculty. Others, such as INSEAD and LBS, are so large that over the years a large number of lecturers have worked there (some on a permanent basis).
